## PHYSICAL PUNISHMENT IN CHILD REARING IN BULGARIA

(Results from an Omnibus Study carried out among Bulgarian population)

Sofia October 2005

## I. PARAMETERS OF THE STUDY

The field work for the execution of the survey was carried out in the period 16 - 30 September 2005.

**Sample**: two-phase cluster sample of a size N = 1000. The executed sample is N = 994 people aged above 15 years.

**Method**: standardized face-to-face in-home interviews.

## II. SURVEY RESULTS<sup>1</sup>

The major objective of the study was to determine the attitudes of Bulgarians towards the use of corporal punishment in child rearing, as well as to evaluate the share of children in Bulgaria who are actually experiencing physical punishment by their parents.

In general the results of the survey are as follows:

- The majority of the respondents (90%) have no difficulty in indicating the share of children in Bulgaria whose upbringing is accompanied by physical punishment. Only a very small part of the respondents, less than 6%, think that there are no children experiencing any form of physical punishment. On the contrary, over 80% of the respondents are of the opinion that children in Bulgaria are being brought up in this way too.
- ✓ The majority of the people indicate the low values of the scale and think that half of the children in the country are subject to corporal punishment.
- There is no definite opinion whether physical punishment should and could be used as a child rearing method. However, almost half of the respondents (47%) reject this method and take the stand that it "should never be used".
- ✓ Almost 40% of the respondents declare their principal disagreement with the use of physical punishment. However, they support the opinion that there are situations when the inclusion even of this method of child rearing is justified.
- Less than one tenth of the respondents declare their support of the use of physical punishments, given that it is the parents' choice. They stand for the right of parents to choose their own methods of child upbringing.

The following more important conclusions could be drawn based on the demographic characteristics of the respondents:

- ✓ People with secondary or lower education more often indicate that in Bulgaria no children are punished physically in their families.
- People who are married, divorced or widowed indicate a lower share of children experiencing physical violence within 1 20%, while according to single persons their share exceeds 50% of the children in Bulgaria.
- The dependence of the respondents' evaluations upon the size of the town or village they live in is interesting. The people living in larger towns or villages indicate a bigger share of children who are brought up using physical punishment. According to the people in small towns and villages this share is lower.
- Respondents having college or higher education, as compared to the remainder educational groups, to a greater extent do not approve the use of physical punishment

- in principle, but they find it justifiable in certain situations. On the other hand, respondents with elementary or no education at all are of the opinion that it is up to parents to decide how to rear their children and that they have the right to use physical punishment if they believe that this is an appropriate and effective way to bring up children.
- These methods are supported largely by the elder representatives of the population. At the same time the youngest, 15 to 19 years of age, and the people aged 40 to 49 are among the opponents of physical punishment and in comparison with the other age groups the greatest part of them give an absolute negative evaluation of it.
- People living in the capital are to a greater extent likely to accept physical punishment as an upbringing method as compared to the remainder of the country's population. People living in rural areas are bigger opponents to this method in comparison with people from other areas.
